In the field we are tuning up our fall and winter storage carrots field, and doing our best to stay up with trellising our summer crops in a context of limited labor and heavy harvests.... Our crop of overwintered onions and garlic are drying down in drying bays now, even while several acres more of fresh, spring-planted shallots and onions are sizing up in our fields. Brassicas of various types, celery and celeriac, chards of all colors, and winter squash of several species are all chugging along through the moderate summer heat, setting roots for healthy fall crops when the days eventually shorten. Crops move at fast speed right now, so we're doing our best to keep up. Hope you are enjoying your summer!
