The Role

We're seeking a responsible and highly motivated person, who loves good food and building community, to lead our Saturday Corvallis Market team

In collaboration with our Markets Coordinator, the Corvallis Market Lead will play a pivotal role in both the function and feel of GTF's market booth, as well as being responsible for communicating with farm management, helping with hiring, supervising and training new marketeers, and the oversight of market equipment and logistics.

This position is intended to be an ongoing position moving into subsequent market seasons, with the markets taking a break between Thanksgiving and New Year each year. This person should reside in the Corvallis/Philomath area. This position can be incorporated into another part-time or full-time position on the farm team, as and when other positions are opened.

Core responsibilities

This position is responsible for safely loading and driving the truck, coordinating all the activities of the market booths, scheduling & managing staff, while representing GTF in a positive, professional manner, and providing great customer service to retail customers and restaurant buyers at the market. Experience in fresh produce retail, food service, or farming is highly desired.

Essential Job Functions – Summary

The Corvallis Market Lead is responsible for market logistics and ensures the market is functioning properly by providing Daily Staff Leadership and:

- Drive Truck to the Market Locations. Refuel when needed. Alternatively, delegate driving to a trusted and trained marketer.
- Work with the market team in unloading and building the canopy and display. And at end of market put it all away safely and in an organized manner.
- Time tracking for each marketer's shift on digital app.
- Review inventory sheet, decide on booth layout, and delegate display and set-up tasks to marketers
- Ensure displays are maintained to appropriate standards, ease of customer access, coordinate the restocking responsibilities
- Assess staffing needs throughout the day.
- Monitoring ongoing sales and inventory levels, and adapting prices to maximize sales
- Competency in handling cash and card transactions, rapid mental arithmetic, and using Square POS systems. Report market token counts.
- Handle payments from restaurants and other special-order customers.
- Scheduling and communicating staffing needs to Markets Coordinator
- Safety

Minimum Requirements:

- Physically capable of standing for long periods of time, lifting totes up to 50 lb, moving heavy display racks and materials above shoulder height.
- A Valid Oregon Driver's License is required; for insurance purposes, no moving violations permissible in the previous 2 years
- The ability to safely and confidently operate a 24 ft. Automatic box truck. (We can train someone without big truck experience, but who is willing to learn)
