The nature of succession planting vegetables is that in order for each planting to come due in the future in a steady fashion, the plantings have to be staggered accordingly. After a consistent rhythm of carrot seedings, for example, our “main season” plantings are all already in place; leaving only our July seedings, which will be destined for late fall and winter storage carrots. Time flies when you’re diversified farming...!

We hope you enjoy the produce week. Here, once these rains pass, the farming team will be hitting full speed trying to keep up with high loads of weeding, harvest, and field making. Wish us luck!
